Step 1: ELIGIBILITY

To be eligible for the Territorial Worship Collective, you must be:

- 1. A Salvationist in good standing at your corps
- 2. Between the ages of 13 25

Auditions will be accepted (and are encouraged) on any voice part and the following instruments: **Acoustic Guitar, Electric Guitar, Bass, Keyboards, and Drums.**

Step 2: COMPLETE APPLICATION

Step 3: RECORD YOUR VIDEO AUDITION

RECORDING: All auditions must be recorded on video. Audio quality of yourself must be prominent and clear.

Each Part of the audition should be recorded in one take, without pausing or editing. Under no circumstances should you splice or edit your audition within a Part. You may choose to edit the two parts together into one video if you wish, but that is not required.

PART 1: Sing your favorite worship song

- o Tell us your name, where you're from and how long you have been involved in corps and/or divisional praise teams.
- o Perform a worship song of your choice. NO original songs. You can play and/or sing alone or with a backing track.

PART 2: Soldiers Hymn (Phil Laeger and Marty Mikles)

NOTE: Play your Part 2 audition backing track from a secondary sound system (this is easily managed using your corps sound system) o VOCALISTS: On the VOCAL track below the lead vocal is included on verse 1 and 2 for the first few bars.

Sing with the VOCAL track the lead vocal on verses 1 and 2 and harmony on verse 3.

o INSTRUMENTALISTS: Play (or play and sing) along with the backing track for your specific instrument.

Step 5: SUBMIT YOUR AUDITION TO THQ


